Thank you to the many members who have paid their 2016 annual subscription fee. Members who paid their 2015 currently have complimentary access the on-line EJPN <http://www.ejpn-journal.com/>, but this will be removed in February if the 2016 fee has not been received.

2016 fees offer great value: since 2015, fees have been reduced for our members in countries classified by the World Bank income groups 1,2 and 3, World Bank income group 4 have the same fees as 2015 and it has been possible to continue to offer the hugely discounted fee for on-line only access to the Journal to all trainees members. Once you have logged in please select 'Subscription', then 'Make new

payment', select your preferred membership type, add to cart, then check-out. There is a 'forgotten your password' facility if you need a password reminder.

The closing date for applications is **29 February 2016** at which point the EPNS Fellowship Selection Committee will consider all applications. Applicants will be informed of the outcome by the end of March 2016. Travel and stay will be supported by the EPNS.

An email will follow later this week with further details and we are thrilled to say that we will be able to agree 2 successful Visiting Teacher applications.
