EPNS Masterclass 2018: registration now open!

We are delighted to announce that registration is now open for the 3rd EPNS Masterclass 2018 entitled 'When to start; when to stop. The dilemmas of advanced medical technology in paediatric neurology'. The event will take place at Cambridge University from 6-8 September 2018. We are building on the unique features of first two Masterclasses, in 2015 and 2017. This will be a small, interactive meeting with delegates attending in "couples" of a senior mentoring clinician and the leaders of tomorrow: to share and learn from each other's ideas in areas where there are no easy answers. We are privileged to have speakers from a wide range of backgrounds including parents, ethicists and senior lawyers, as well as experienced clinicians; and will draw on the Cambridge tradition of rigorous, respectful,

intellectual exchange across the artificial boundaries of academic disciplines. Bursaries will be available for 2 mentor and young neurologist couples.

CALL FOR LETTER OF INTENT TO BID TO HOST THE EPNS 3 year training course cycle

The EPNS is now inviting interested parties to submit a letter of intent to bid to host the EPNS 3-year training course cycle from 2021 – 2023. Also, if the standard of bids are of a high quality, the EPNS may also appoint the host for the 2024 – 2026 training course cycle from the bids received. The deadline for <u>letters of intent</u> to be received by the EPNS is midnight 30 April 2018.

Since 2003, the EPNS has been organising training courses in paediatric neurology. These are aimed at trainees and qualified paediatric neurologists who want to update their knowledge in specific fields. In 2009 the EPNS introduced a format where an individual centre would host the courses for a three-year period. We hold one meeting a year; each meeting offering two Courses. Most topics in the syllabus are covered over this three-year cycle. The courses also promote contact between individuals in the speciality from different parts of Europe and beyond. The style of teaching combines lectures, workshops, quizzes and interactive sessions. The courses have a highly interactive character and participants are encouraged to bring (difficult) cases to discuss.

The settings have had an atmosphere conducive to study with the venues offering local interest and good facilities for the main lectures, break-out rooms for workshops and audiovisual aids. - Ani Gevorgyan from Arabkir MC-ICAH Armenia will be going to the Royal Victoria Infirmary, Newcastle upon Tyne, United Kingdom: I was very happy and appreciative to learn that I was selected as one of the recipients of EPNS Fellowship 2018. This Fellowship will provide exceptional opportunity to visit an excellent tertiary center, to see patients with different neurological diseases and "to shadow" a knowledgeable supervisor. I hope to see patients with rare neurological disorders, to gain experience and knowledge in getting to a diagnosis of these patients, to get familiar with the latest therapeutic approaches. In my country we have limited experience with identification and diagnosis of rare diseases because of a small size of the population. After improving my skills I will try to apply them in my country, to take better care of our patients, to contribute to the development of pediatric neurology in Armenia.
