## CALL FOR LETTER OF INTENT TO BID TO HOST THE EPNS 3 year training course cycle

The EPNS is now inviting interested parties to submit a letter of intent to bid to host the EPNS 3-year training course cycle from 2021 – 2023. Also, if the standard of bids are of a high quality, the EPNS may also appoint the host for the 2024 – 2026 training course cycle from the bids received. The deadline for <u>letters of intent</u> to be received by the EPNS is midnight 30 April 2018.

Since 2003, the EPNS has been organising training courses in paediatric neurology. These are aimed at trainees and qualified paediatric neurologists who want to update their knowledge in specific fields. In 2009 the EPNS introduced a format where an individual centre would host the courses for a three-year period. We hold one meeting a year; each meeting offering two Courses. Most topics in the syllabus are covered over this three-year cycle. The courses also promote contact between individuals in the speciality from different parts of Europe and beyond. The style of teaching combines lectures, workshops, quizzes and interactive sessions. The courses have a highly interactive character and participants are encouraged to bring (difficult) cases to discuss.

The settings have had an atmosphere conducive to study with the venues offering local interest and good facilities for the main lectures, break-out rooms for workshops and audio-visual aids. The EPNS has been thrilled to award 6 EPNS Fellowships this year. As promised, we will continue to share updates. This month here are summaries from 2 EPNS members who have recently been awarded an EPNS Fellowship about their goals:

- Dr Iva Separovic from University Clinical Hospital Center Sestre milosrdnice, Zagreb, 0 Croatia will be going to University Medical Centre Groningen, the Netherlands: I am a member of child neurology team as a resident at Paediatrics clinic, UHC Sestre milosrdnice, Zagreb, Croatia. This fellowship will enable me to participate in the activities at the Institute of Developmental Neurology, Beatrix Children's Hospital, University Medical Center Groningen in Groningen, the Netherlands, starting in September 2018. I'm honoured to be offered an opportunity to work with Prof. Hadders-Algra.
