With an overall number of over 1,100 delegates from approx. 70 countries, the meetings were a huge success and surpassed all expectations! I would like to offer my personal thanks to Gunther Bernert and his team, together with Jean-Pierre Lin for organising such wonderful events. The meetings presented an outstanding scientific programme and excellent networking opportunities. I hope that those of you who were able to join us in Vienna agree, and that the new information provided during the symposium and congress will support your continuing medical education and daily work. A deserved 'well done' to our 2 congress award winners too! – see below. Plans are already in the pipeline for the 12th EPNS Congress which will be taking place in Lyon, France, 20-24 June 2017, and I am sure this will at least match the quality of our meeting last week, so remember to mark the date in your 2017 diary! During the EPNS Board meeting in Vienna we were presented with the bids to host Congress 2019. The EPNS is thrilled to have awarded a further 3 more EPNS Fellowships. (That is a total of 5 Fellowships awarded in 2015, and 3 in 2014). We will be re-opening the opportunity to apply for a Fellowship for 2016 at a later date, so watch this space! (remember applicants must have been a member of the EPNS for atleast 6 months to be eligible to apply).

 Dr Constantinos Anastasopoulos from Germany going to High Field MRI Cent, Leiden, The Netherlands The centre I will be visiting focuses on the emerging field of high-field MRI, i.e. the application of new acquisition methods on strong magnetic scanners. I will come in close contact with the experimental methodology of radiologists, paediatricians and scientists studying the imaging of human muscle in neuromuscular disorders. As clinical practice goes hand in hand with scientific advance, I will profit from this short stay in both aspects. I hope to gain skills in measurement of muscle strength as well as in the acquisition and interpretation of muscle MRI scans, quantification of fatty infiltration, inflammation and atrophy in muscles of patients with muscular dystrophies. I am grateful that the EPNS board gave me this opportunity

- Dr Miquel Angel Fernandez Garcia from Spain going to Hopital Neckar, Paris, France My name is Miguel Ángel Fernández García. I am a young paediatrician from Spain, currently developing my training and educational programme in Pediatric Neurology at Hospital Infantil Universitario Niño Jesús, from Madrid (Spain). I will spend my Fellowship at the neuromuscular department of Hôpital Necker Enfants-Malades from Paris. My goal is to improve my clinical skills and gain experience on the field of neuromuscular diseases, including its diagnosis, management and particular evaluation with neurophysiology and muscle biopsy. Besides the fact that this will enrich my general neuropediatric training, I am now taking an active part in research by writing a PhD work on the topic of mitochondrial diseases. Thus, this fellowship at the neuromuscular department will lead me to analyse neuromuscular dysfunctions and its differential diagnosis, as well as to expand my knowledge on mitochondrial diseases, which will greatly help my thesis. I am also highly motivated for intercultural learning, which will broaden my vision of the Pediatric Neurology. And I wholeheartedly hope to be able to take back all this precious training opportunity into my future daily practise. Finally, I would like to highlight the effort of the EPNS in accomplishing its objectives of ensuring training opportunities for young members, encouraging international exchanges and fostering cooperation among all European Pediatric Neurologists. I am very thankful.
- Dr Katharina Villi from Germany going to John Walter Neuro Muscular Dystrophy Cent, Newcastle United Kingdom I very much appreciate the award for an EPNS Fellowship. There are already concrete plans to arrive in Newcastle, (Institute of Genetic Medicine, University of Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 3BZ, England, hosting supervisor will be Prof. Volker Straub) in September for the first 3 weeks of the fellowship. During that period I am planned be involved in their neuromuscular outpatient clinics, in the assessment of patients in several of the clinical trials, and in the diagnostic workup of patients through exome sequencing.

EPNS Fellowship 2014: feedback

For your information, we were recently delighted to receive feedback from Dr Lyudmila Yepiskoposyan from Armenia who was successfully awarded an EPNS fellowship in 2014. Her fellowship was undertaken at Univ. Children's Hospital Gasthuisberg in Belgium from January until April 2015. The aim of her study was EEG training, which is not included in her residency programme. Dr Yepiskoposyan said it was a great opportunity for her to become familiar with the technique of performing EEG and basics of EEG reading. She also had an opportunity to see patients with epilepsy, to understand use of EEG in the diagnostic work up and to increase knowledge on the principles of therapy in epilepsies as well as also new approaches in the management of these patients. Dr Yepiskoposyan learnt the principles of different montages, how to perform provocation methods, waking and sleep EEG patterns, to recognize epileptic and non-epileptic sharp phenomena, benign variants and artifacts. In addition to concentrating on what she set out to learn Dr Yepiskoposyan also had a possibility to choose a certain type of epilepsy (infantile spasms) and to read a significant amount of these EEGs in order to be ready for much more detailed interpretation. She has read several EEGs of the same patient and could see the evolution of different seizure types. Dr Yepiskoposyan has thanked the EPNS for this opportunity!

7th Euro Paediatrics Congress, Florence, 13-15 May, 2015

Our EPNS Board members, Banu Anlar and Rob Forsyth represented the EPNS at the 7th Euro Paediatrics Congress, Florence, 13--/15 May, 2015. They gave a workshop on practical neurological examination, personal practice courses on gait abnormalities and developmental delays, and a "hot topics" session. Banu Anlar participated to the summit about independent pediatric congresses in Europe including EPA/UNEPSA and subspecialist societies. The next EAP Congress will be in Bucharest, 2017.
