The EPNS has been thrilled to award 6 EPNS Fellowships this year. As promised, we will continue to share updates. This month here are summaries from 2 EPNS members who have recently been awarded an EPNS Fellowship about their goals and aspirations:

- - o I'm very thankful for the opportunity given by awarding me with an EPNS fellowship. The focus of my research work in general is impact of different white matter segments damage on neurodevelopmental and electroencephalographic features in premature children. During my fellowship at the Hopital Femme Mere Enfant / Epilepsie, Sommeil & Explorations Fonctionnelles Neupediatriques in Lyon, France, I will learn, under the supervision of Prof. Alexis Arzimanoglou, about EEG maturation, pathological EEG findings and sleep disorders, polisomnography in children as well as expand my knowledge in the field of childhood and adolescence epilepsies
- Dr Esra Serdaroglu from Turkey going to Evelina London Children's Hospital, United Kingdom. Awarded a Clinical Fellowship.
 - I am very grateful to EPNS for this opportunity. My primary focus is paediatric movement disorders. My aim is to learn about the semiological assessment, the diagnostic decision-making process for these patients, and observe treatment strategies like intrathecal baclofen pump and deep brain stimulation. I plan to deepen my knowledge on evaluation of movement disorders under the supervision of Dr Jean-Pierre Lin, at Evelina Children's Hospital, London.

RESCUE ESES (<u>RandomizedEuropean trial of Steroids versus ClobazamUsage</u> in <u>Encephalopathy with ElectricalStatus Epilepticus in Sleep</u>) is a prospective intervention study in patients with Epileptic Encephalopathy with Electrical Status Epilepticus in Sleep (ESES), with the primary aim to compare efficacy of treatment with steroids and clobazam with respect to cognitive outcome.
