EPNS Research Awards

Huge congratulations to our 2 Research Award winners! There is an EPNS Research Prize awarded at every EPNS Research Meeting. The EPNS Research Prize this year was awarded to two young neurologists who presented outstanding, innovative ideas in an area of research in Paediatric Neurology. The following have been awarded research funds of 2500 euro each and have sent these messages:

- **Dr Walid Fazeli** from Germany 'I am delighted and feel honoured to have received the EPNS Research Prize 2016. The research award recognizes the translational relevance of our work and encourages us to pursue our investigations of the SCN2A mouse model with a particular focus on epileptogenesis and therapeutic strategies. I am particularly pleased that the award acknowledges my effort as a clinician to better understand mechanisms underlying genetic epilepsies by working in a basic science laboratory.'
- **Dr Ralista Yordanova** from Bulgaria For me 'It is a really great honour to be awarded with the EPNS Research Prize 2016. This is a recognition that developmental assessment and surveillance with standardized and population based tools in preschool children is of great importance. I am truly grateful about the award and believe that it will help us to improve developmental assessment in Bulgarian preschool children'

C N A meeting

The Commission of National Advisers (CNA) is constituted of advisers selected by the national Paediatric Neurology (PN) societies and associations of all European countries inside and outside the European Union (EU). Normally each country is represented by one member. Therefore the CNA is the representative for Europe. More information can be found on the EPNS website <u>http://www.epns.jmre.es/cna/</u>

On 28 October 2016, the C N A held its 18th meeting in Essen. This was a constructive meeting where the participants agreed to work together to develop a central database relating to PN in each European country. The information in this database will assist both the EPNS in taking further action in aiming for homogenous training in PN in Europe, and countries to improve their PN training concordant to the EPNS Syllabus and the organization of the PN care using successful models from other countries and adapting these to the realities from their country. Data will serve to publish an article in the EJPN showing the current situation of PN in Europe. This article will be a powerful point of reference for countries to use in the future with statistical information about the specialty. Another important discussion point concerned on how more students and trainees can be encouraged to enter the field of PN in the future.
