

# How much do I need to pay in 2022?

The fee paid in 2022 depends on TWO factors:

 The World Bank income category your country belongs to. Here is the list of World Bank Classification 4 high income nations <u>CLICK HERE</u> WB4A = Class 4 high income nations on the above list <u>not highlighted</u>. WB4B = Class 4 high income nations on the above list <u>highlighted in blue</u>. WB123 = countries not Class 4 high income nations, i.e. <u>not on the list above</u>. Trainee = trainees from ALL nations regardless of classification GNP = mutual members of the Gesellschaft für Neuropädiatrie (GNP) and the EPNS

If your trainee letter has expire, you must email info@epns.info with an updated letter or confirm you are no longer a trainee.

### 1. Pay online

- Once successfully logged into the member section of the EPNS website:
  - Select 'Make a Payment' (top menu)
  - Choose your preferred membership type: online journal only or printed copy of journal as well
  - Select 'add to basket' underneath your chosen membership type
  - Select 'proceed to check-out'
  - If required, complete your billing details.
- Select either:
  - Credit Cards (VISA, Mastercard) note also debit cards are accepted here
  - Direct Bank Transfer: Important, please note direct bank transfer is not paid on-line. Please instruct your bank to send the funds by money transfer and quote your last name and Order ID in the reference.
- Select 'place order'
  - o If you selected 'credit card' complete the requested fields
  - If you selected 'direct bank transfer' please instruct your bank to send the payment. The EPNS bank details and order ID will be made available to you when you select 'place order'.
